Membership Policy

Adopted on:

1. Purpose

Membership at Kingdom Faith Worship Centre (KFWC) is a covenant relationship. It signifies commitment to Christ, participation in the life of the church, and partnership in fulfilling the church's mission. This policy defines how individuals become members, their responsibilities, and the processes for review and accountability.

2. Membership Process

1. Application

- Prospective members complete a membership application form.
- Applicants must profess faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

2. Membership Class

- Applicants attend a class introducing the vision, mission, values, and beliefs of KFWC.
- The class will also outline member responsibilities, including service, giving, and participation.

3. Leadership Review

- Applications are reviewed by church leadership (Pastors, Elders, or Board).
- Interviews may be conducted to affirm readiness and understanding.

3. Categories of Membership

- **Active Members** – fully engaged in worship, service, and giving.
- **Associate Members** – individuals who participate in the life of KFWC but hold membership in another church.

4. Commitments of Membership

Members are expected to:

- Regularly attend worship services and prayer meetings.
- Support the church through faithful giving and tithes.
- Serve in at least one ministry or area of church life.
- Uphold the values, unity, and witness of KFWC.
- Submit to church leadership and biblical accountability.

5. Review of Membership

- Membership may be reviewed if a member consistently neglects attendance, giving, or service without reasonable cause.
- Members who move away or join another church will be removed from the roll upon confirmation.
- Members who fall into misconduct will be counselled. If unresolved, leadership may suspend or remove their membership.

6. Removal and Restoration

- Grounds for removal include prolonged absence, refusal of accountability, or conduct contrary to the faith and values of KFWC.
- Removal is a last resort and will be approved by leadership.
- Restoration is encouraged. Members who repent and seek renewal may be reinstated following review by leadership.

7. Transfer of Membership

- Members transferring into KFWC from another church will follow the application process and present a letter of good standing where possible.
- Members transferring out will, upon request, receive a letter confirming their standing with KFWC.

8. Accountability

- Membership records will be maintained and reviewed annually.
- The Board and Pastors will oversee membership matters, ensuring decisions are guided by prayer, fairness, and biblical principles.

Membership at Kingdom Faith Worship Centre is both a privilege and a responsibility, reflecting a shared journey of faith, growth, and service.
